



FSSD BUS RULES AND REGULATIONS

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY AND KEEP THIS PAGE FOR YOUR RECORDS

The school bus is an extension of school; therefore, students should conduct themselves in a manner consistent with established safety standards and classroom conduct. Bus students are under the supervision and control of the bus driver while on his/her bus.

STUDENTS ARE TO RIDE ONLY ON ASSIGNED BUSES.

Under no circumstance should students ride a bus to which they are not assigned.

Board Policy specifically states: "Under no circumstances shall students be transported past their assigned school or to a place other than their in-zone residence."

To ensure safe and orderly means of transportation, the following guiding principles are established for riders:

- **Be at the Bus Stop prior to the arrival of the bus.**
- **Wait on the sidewalk, away from the curb, until the bus comes to a complete stop.**
- **Go directly to an available seat and be seated in order to keep aisles and exits clear.**
- **Keep noise at classroom level.**
- **Keep head, hands, and objects inside the bus.**
- **Respect the rights and property of others.**
- **Obey the driver promptly and respectfully.**
- **If the driver does not see the expected and customary safe environment for any student exiting the bus after school, that student will be asked to re-board the bus. Any student refusal to re-board the bus will require law enforcement involvement.**
- **Remain seated until the bus has come to a complete stop and use the emergency door only in an emergency.**
- **No drugs, weapons, hazardous materials, or animals allowed on the bus.**
- **No objects permitted on board that can't be held in a student's lap.**
- **No profanity, chewing gum, eating or drinking on the bus.**
- **No throwing or passing objects allowed on, from, or into the bus.**
- **The bus radio may be played at the driver's discretion. Student requests will be considered to encourage proper behavior on the bus. Please call the Transportation Dept. if you have concerns.**

CONSEQUENCES:

1. A Bus Conduct Report will be completed by the bus driver as a warning and forwarded to the principal.
2. Two (2) Bus Conduct Reports will result in a three- to five-day suspension from the privilege of riding the bus.
3. Three (3) Bus Conduct Reports will result in an additional ten (10) days suspension from the privilege of riding the bus.
4. Four (4) Bus Conduct Reports or zero tolerance offenses will result in suspension from the privilege of riding the bus for the remainder of the school year.
5. The parent/legal guardian is held legally responsible for any damage to the bus and/or bus equipment by his/her child.

Depending on the severity of the offense, other consequences may be assigned, and a student could be assigned up to the maximum consequence the first time the offense is committed.
